The following is a summary of the actions taken at the March 4, 2020 meeting and a copy of the proceedings can be obtained by contacting the District Manager.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Mr. Torres called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and called the roll.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Audience Comments

There being none, the next item followed.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Affidavit of Publication

A copy of the affidavit of publication of the public hearing was included in the agenda package.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Organizational Matters

A. Appointment of New Supervisor to Fill Seat 5

March 4, 2020 Ridgewood Trails CDD

B. Oath of Office for Newly Appointed Supervisor

C. Election of Officers Resolution 2020-03

This item tabled.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Approval of the Minutes of the January 8, 2020 Meeting

On MOTION by Ms. Miller seconded by Mr. Genska with all in favor the minutes of the January 8, 2020 meeting were approved as presented.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Hearing Adopting Rates for the Use of the District's Recreational Facilities, Resolution 2020-04

Mr. Torres stated as discussed at our January meeting this facility is now available to be rented. The proposed fees are: meeting room \$150 with a \$250 deposit, meeting room with the pool \$200 with a \$500 deposit. We set the bar high so if you needed to lower the fees you can do so at this public hearing; you just can't exceed those amounts.

Mr. Genska asked will you explain the annual user fee?

Mr. Torres stated we are a public entity and that is to allow non-residents to pay an annual fee of \$950 to have the same privileges as the residents. At this time there is no one participating in this program.

The resolution only covers the fees to be charged to rent this room and this room with the pool.

On MOTION by Mr. Genska seconded by Ms. Miller with all in favor the public hearing was opened.

Mr. Torres stated typically we ask for two checks, one for the rental and one for the deposit and if there is no damage and the room is left in good order and clean after the rental, staff will return the deposit check and will only process the check for the rental fee. The rental is for five-hour increments.

A resident asked why is it so high for residents, when we pay the annual fee to use these facilities?

Mr. Torres responded usually with a rental there is a little bit more wear and tear than normal usage. Also, there may be additional staffing requirements. We also advertised a very high rate to allow the board some flexibility to be able to reduce it based on the discussions and comments tonight.

Mr. Genska stated if you rent this room or this room and pool it is not available to anybody else.

A resident asked if someone rents this room a resident can't use the pool?

Mr. Genska stated if they rent the room and the pool, that would be for the people renting it. That is the little pool, not the big pool.

A resident stated we pay a fee for this. Don't we get a discount as a resident?

Mr. Genska stated we set the rate high so we can talk about it. We can't go higher, we can only go lower.

Mr. Porter joined the meeting at this time.

A resident asked does the rental fee include an insurance rider or is the person who rents this required to bring insurance? If you rent this pool and there is 25 people there and one drowns who is liable, the person who rented it and he supplies the insurance or the association apply the insurance on their policy? How is the insurance handled?

Mr. Porter stated that is really a question for our attorney. The CDD does have insurance, the CDD also has sovereign immunity that limits the amount of the claim.

A resident stated so we could rent this place and if someone were injured the renter would be held harmless.

Mr. Porter responded no, we would not be doing hold harmless. My experience is if you rent the place and someone gets injured, they will sue the district, they will sue the manager, they will sue you, they will sue everybody else in the pool. I would not expect the district to do a hold harmless.

Ms. Buchanan stated I would point out that because the district is likely to be a target of the lawsuit just because that is the world we live in, it is incumbent upon the district to put in policies and procedures to make sure that people pay attention and take care of the facilities. That is part of what the board is trying to do today by requiring the larger deposit we are ensuring that responsible people are going to be renting the facilities we are not just opening the door and making it easy to abuse the pool and the amenity facility. I would also note that the district does have

insurance and we are protected by sovereign immunity, which means that the district is not the most wealthy party in the room. Generally liability for incidents that occur on district property would be capped at \$200,000 liability limitation.

Residents brought up and discussed the following items: amount of rental and amount of deposits, cancellation policy, ability to use the slide when renting the room and small pool, ability to use the slide seven-days a week, ability to add those costs to an upcoming budget, deposit check returned if there is no damage to the room, capacity of room limited to 30, could additional parking be provided by the playground, rental for room and room and pool is broken into 5-hour increments weekends only.

It was the consensus of the residents that \$50 for the room rental and \$75 for the room and the pool rental were acceptable.

On MOTION by Mr. Porter seconded by Mr. Genska with all in favor the public hearing was closed.

On MOTION by Mr. Porter seconded by Ms. Nolte with all in favor Resolution 2020-04 was approved reflecting a room rental of \$50 with a \$250 security deposit and room and pool rental of \$75 with a security deposit of \$500.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Amenities Rules & Policies

Mr. Torres stated some of the changes to the amenities rules and policies are administrative and the main changes are on pages 11, 12 & 13 about the rental of this facility. The one issue we have heard from the residents was making it available to be rented during the week and the consensus was that we would change that, so I made that change to the rules. You can approve this in substantial form pending the changes of adding the weekdays available for rental that would satisfy the comments from the residents. We consolidated the fee structure in one document and that was a handout but there were no changes to the fees.

Mr. Genska asked did we decide the number of attendees that is TBD, did we decide that is 30?

Mr. Porter stated I think 30 is a reasonable number.

Mr. Genska asked what is the fire code capacity?

Ms. Brown stated 48.

Mr. Porter stated we are adopting a set of rules and fees for now and if it doesn't work for everybody we will address it again.

On MOTION by Mr. Porter seconded by Ms. Miller with all in favor the amenities rules and policies were approved in substantial form with changes in room capacity to be 30 and to allow weekday rentals.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Resolution 2020-05 Adopting Internal Controls

Mr. Torres stated there was a change in the statute requiring us to adopt internal controls. We have always had internal controls, which are mentioned in the audit every year, but this formalizes the internal controls.

On MOTION by Mr. Porter seconded by Mr. Genska with all in favor Resolution 2020-05 was approved.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Resident Survey

Mr. Torres stated we prepared a survey, the board provided feedback and before we send it out, I would like to get formal approval.

Mr. Porter stated I think we are good you can go ahead and send it out.

TENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Pond Aerator or Fountain Proposals

Mr. Torres stated at the last meeting a supervisor requested staff to provide a proposal for one pond.

Mr. Hall stated the pond in back, I met with Lake Doctors out there and I provided you with a map of that lake because the south side of that lake doesn't have enough water in it for the traditional fountain, it is very shallow; we can get one on the other side. I will provide prices of a couple different companies and the electricity to get to that side would have to go under a driveway, through our easement and back to the other side, which is going to be about \$5,000 in addition to the cost of the fountain.

A resident asked is it possible to use solar power?

Mr. Hall stated I can look into that. I talked to Lake Doctors and if we don't choose to put in a fountain or aerator he has ideas such as carp and aquatic plants to spruce it up and make it look nicer.

- Mr. Porter stated that is less expensive and less maintenance.
- Mr. Hall stated since it is so shallow they said aquatic plants would do fantastic in there.
- Mr. Porter stated if you put a fountain in a shallow pond you have to keep fixing it. I am opposed to doing that, I think it is a waste of money.

ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Staff Reports

A. Attorney

There being none, the next item followed.

B. Engineer

There being none, the next item followed.

C. Manager – General Election

Mr. Torres stated at the beginning of the meeting I mentioned the vacancy we have and I hope to get some interest from residents who are here tonight to consider at the next meeting. During the general election those seats that are expiring, Mr. Porter's seat and the vacant seat will have to go through the qualifying process that is in early June.

Mr. Porter stated if you would like to qualify, go to the supervisor of elections, fill in some paperwork. If nobody bothers to qualify we will ask for volunteers and the board will appoint somebody to fill those seats. We have one seat that is vacant and mine is expiring and if any of you would like to be on this board let Ernesto know and we can have you appointed right away and sworn in. I am not a resident and if two people want to get on the board now I don't mind stepping down so someone else can take over. I will be out in November anyway.

Mr. Torres stated the next meeting is in May and it is going to be a 6:00 p.m. and traditionally that is the meeting at which we approve the budget. I'm working with Chris Hall and Melissa Brown and there may be some slight adjustment to the budget on contracts and utilities, but I will bring that to the board for approval at the May meeting.

Mr. Porter stated in May the board will approve a budget so it can be advertised and notices can be sent to everybody, then we will have a public hearing to adopt the budget. The budget will be posted on the website before the May meeting so look through it and most of the money in the budget is going for things like a contract for landscaping services, pool maintenance, maintenance of the facilities and so forth. When we look at facilities management and that kind of thing that is where we talk about how many days is the slide open. If you think it should be open more we will get a proposal that has it open more and we can talk about how much we are going to spend on the slide. Try to get involved in the budget, it is your budget, it is your money and it is going to show up on your tax bill and you have no choice but to pay it so get involved. We will approve it in May and have the public hearing in July to finalize it and when the public hearing is over the board will vote to adopt some number. The number will not be any more than advertised.

D. Operation Manager's Report –Report

Mr. Hall gave an overview of the Operation Manager's monthly report was included as part of the agenda package.

E. Amenity Manager

Ms. Brown stated I am trying to update the database so everybody is well informed. I have updated emails, the correct person is at that address and I'm going through house by house so if I don't have all of your information in the system I'm sending letters out. I have sent out 150 out and only gotten 10 back. If you are getting a letter and I'm not here you can put it in the mailbox or in the little bin. If you haven't gotten a letter then you are up to date but if you get them back to me I can keep you informed on things. I'm here Monday through Friday usually from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

TWELFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Supervisor's Requests and Audience Comments

Mr. Porter stated this is the last couple months of me being on the board. I live in a place where CDD board meetings go for five hours or more. I try to keep meetings to an hour or less and it makes it easy to get people to be willing to be on a board and it helps you get people willing to come to the meetings. Regardless of who is running it I suggest you try to keep that in mind.

Mr. Genska asked did the street signs get finished in the new development across Long Branch? I had a comment from our mail carrier.

Mr. Hall stated if they haven't I will contact the county.

Mr. Palanica stated I understand the maintenance fee we pay. What I don't think any of us in the Freedom section understand is what is a CDD and what is the HOA. Can someone let us know where that break is?

Mr. Porter stated the CDD basically takes care of the entry, general mowing, the ponds, the stuff behind the gate is private, which means the CDD doesn't take care of it. The CDD owns this facility and this whole island surrounded by the road out here with football and the rest of it. All the stuff behind the gate is the HOA.

Mr. Palanica asked what about in front of the gate where the fountain is, is that CDD or HOA?

Mr. Porter stated I think that is HOA, I'm not positive but if you contact your HOA for the Freedom section they can tell you.

A resident stated this is a fantastic room and it should be utilized and you are only utilizing it 30% by allowing 30 people to come in here. If you put 40 people in there you still have a 20% cushion.

Mr. Porter stated we have already adopted the rule that has a maximum of 30 people, we are not going to change that tonight. If that turns into a problem, then we will address it in the future.

A resident stated I have a concern about the landscaping. I know we have a different company but I don't think they are any better than the previous company. They are cutting the grass way too short. I own a house on the main sidewalk that goes from the back to the front and they always cut it way too short. We need to find a solution for that.

Mr. Torres stated if you notice they are cutting it too short then tell us throughout the month when they are doing it, that way we can take corrective action instead of waiting for a meeting.

Mr. Porter stated in general if you have a problem with one of the services that we have such as landscaping get in touch with Ernesto and he will follow-up on that.

A resident stated I'm on the HOA and we are getting a lot of questions and there have been a lot of different answers going around. What can be done if anything about this main road about

sprucing up the landscaping? At one point there were a bunch of palm trees, there was a rumor going around that you should have never put the palm trees in because it belongs to the county.

Mr. Porter stated that was not a rumor, that is the truth, those palm trees should never have been put in they were not legal so we had to move them and the ones that hadn't died they moved back here. We can probably get them to approve some sort of shrubs but not trees.

Mr. Hall stated we already approved that we are just waiting for spring. We don't have irrigation down here so that is all we can do unless we run irrigation and that is more expensive.

A resident stated I notice in the new section, the phase by the church, but there is a sign that says Azalea Ridge, and that is part of this neighborhood but if you are coming from Old Jennings you can't see the sign because it is behind a fence. My concern is it has been improperly installed. The point is to let somebody know that neighborhood is there and the name of the neighborhood.

Mr. Porter stated I will look into that.

Mr. Torres stated the section we were talking about earlier about the area by the Freedom section belongs to Freedom Azalea Ridge

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE RIDGEWOOD TRAILS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING PROPOSED BUDGETS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021; DECLARING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO FUND THE PROPOSED BUDGETS PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 170, 190 AND 197, FLORIDA STATUTES; SETTING PUBLIC HEARINGS; ADDRESSING PUBLICATION; ADDRESSING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the District Manager has heretofore prepared and submitted to the Board of Supervisors ("Board") of the Ridgewood Trails Community Development District ("District") prior to June 15, 2020, proposed budgets ("Proposed Budget") for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021 ("Fiscal Year 2020/2021"); and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District to fund the administrative and operations services (together, "Services") set forth in the Proposed Budget by levy of special assessments pursuant to Chapters 170, 190 and 197, Florida Statutes ("Assessments"), as set forth in the preliminary assessment roll included within the Proposed Budget; and

WHEREAS, the District hereby determines that benefits would accrue to the properties within the District, as outlined within the Proposed Budget, in an amount equal to or in excess of the Assessments, and that such Assessments would be fairly and reasonably allocated as set forth in the Proposed Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the Proposed Budget, including the Assessments, and desires to set the required public hearings thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE RIDGEWOOD TRAILS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

- 1. PROPOSED BUDGET APPROVED. The Proposed Budget prepared by the District Manager for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved as the basis for conducting a public hearing to adopt said Proposed Budget.
- 2. DECLARING ASSESSMENTS. Pursuant to Chapters 170, 190 and 197, Florida Statutes, the Assessments shall defray the cost of the Services in the total estimated amounts set forth in the Proposed Budget. The nature of, and plans and specifications for, the Services to be funded by the Assessments are described in the Proposed Budget, which is on file and available for public inspection at the "District's Office," c/o Governmental Management Services, 475 West Town Place, Suite 114, World Golf Village, St. Augustine, Florida 32092, (904) 940-5850. The Assessments shall be levied within the District on all benefitted lots and lands, and shall be apportioned, all as described in the Proposed Budget and the preliminary assessment roll included therein. The preliminary assessment roll is also on file and available for public inspection at the District's Office. The Assessments shall be paid in one more installments pursuant to a bill

issued by the District in November of 2020, and pursuant to Chapter 170, Florida Statutes, or, alternatively, pursuant to the *Uniform Method* as set forth in Chapter 197, Florida Statutes.

REVENUES:

Maintenance Assessments

The District will levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all the platted lots within the District to pay all of the operating expenses for the Fiscal Year in accordance with the adopted budget.

Interest Income/Miscellaneous Income

The District will have all excess funds invested with the State Board of Administration. The amount is based upon the estimated average balance of funds available during the fiscal year. This line includes miscellaneous deposits for the district.

EXPENDITURES:

Administrative:

Supervisor Fees/FICA Expense

The Florida Statutes allows each board member to receive \$200 per meeting not to exceed \$4,800 in one year plus associated payroll taxes.

Engineering

The District's engineering firm, England, Thims & Miller, Inc., will be providing general engineering services to the District, including attendance and preparation for monthly board meetings, review invoices, etc.

<u>Assessment Roll</u>

GMS, LLC serves as the District's collection agent and certifies the District's non-ad valorem assessments with the county tax collector.

Arbitrage

The District is required to have an annual arbitrage rebate calculation prepared for the District's Series 2007A/B Special Assessment Bonds.

Dissemination

The Annual Disclosure Report required by the Security and Exchange Commission in order to comply with Rule 15(c)(2)-12(b)(5), which relates to additional reporting requirements for un-rated bond issues.

Attorney

The District's legal counsel, Hopping Green & Sams, will be providing general legal services to the District, including attendance and preparation for monthly meetings, preparation and review of agreements, resolutions, etc.

Annual Audit

The District is required annually to conduct an audit of its financial records by an Independent CPA Firm.

<u>Trustee</u>

The District issued \$11,255,000 Series 2007A/B Special Assessment Bonds are held by a Trustee with US Bank, N.A. The amount of the trustee fee is based on the agreement between US Bank and the District for the Series 2007A/B bonds.

Management Fees

The District receives Management, Accounting and Administrative services as part of a Management Agreement with Governmental Management Services, LLC.

<u>Telephone</u>

This item includes the cost of a telephone and fax machine.

<u>Postage</u>

This item includes mailing of agenda packages, overnight deliveries, correspondence, etc.

Printing & Binding

Printing and Binding agenda packages for board meetings, printing of computerized checks, stationary, envelopes etc.

Insurance

The District's General Liability & Public Officials Liability Insurance policy is with Florida Insurance Alliance. FIA specializes in providing insurance coverage to governmental agencies.

Legal Advertising

The District is required to advertise various notices for monthly Board meetings, public hearings etc in the Florida Times Union.

Other Current Charges

Bank charges and any other miscellaneous expenses which includes ADA Human Audit fee of \$1200 incurred during the year.

Office Supplies

This item includes the cost of miscellaneous office supplies.

<u>Dues</u>, <u>Licenses & Subscriptions</u>

The District is required to pay an annual fee to the Department of Community Affairs for \$175. This is the only expense under this category for the District.

Capital Outlay

Represents any minor capital expenditures the District may need to make during the Fiscal Year such as a file cabinet for District files.

Meeting Room Rental

The District has contracted with Riverside Management Services to staff the amenity center and manage the day to day operations in accordance with their contract.

General Facility Maintenance

Cost of routine repairs and maintenance to the Amenity Center.

L<u>ifeguards</u>

The District has contracted with Riverside Management Services, Inc. to provide lifeguard services during pool operation season.

Pool Maintenance

The District has contracted with Riverside Management Services, Inc. to provide pool maintenance services three (3) days a week. Services include vacuuming, skimming tiles, brushing tiles, pool and equipment inspections, cleaning of filters and any necessary emergency calls.

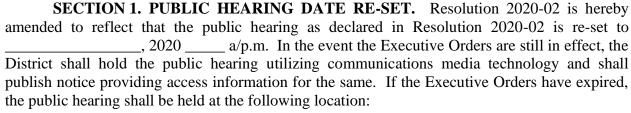

- Irrigation inspections are being performed monthly and repairs are made as needed.

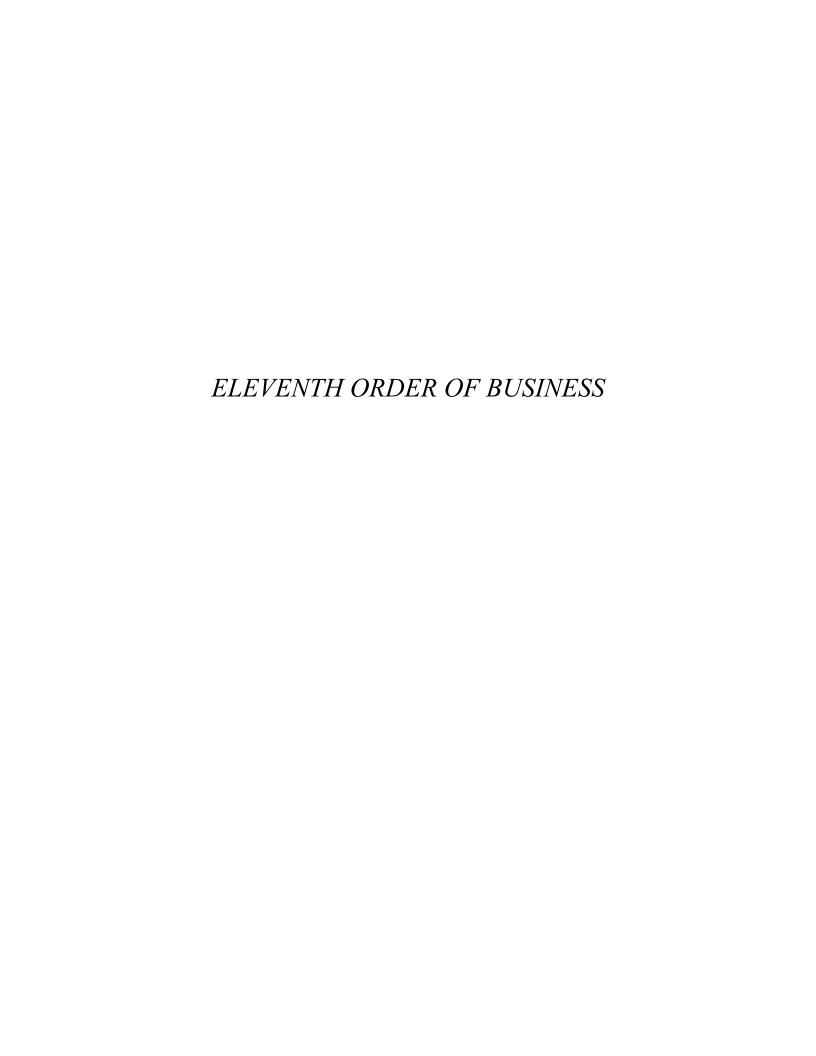
